| Hazard | Level of Risk | Precautions to be implemented |
|---|---------------|--|
| Deep Water (Drowning) | Low | Site Safety Talk. Work to only be carried out by teams of two or more to minimise risk. |
| Uneven Ground. Slip and Trip Hazards | Medium | Site Safety Talk. Sturdy Footwear only must be worn. Site materials and equipment must be kept tidy. |
| Hand Tools and Equipment | Medium | Safety Talk before use. Gloves and Goggles should be worn when cutting, pruning and scything. |
| Power Tools and Equipment | Medium | Safety Talk before use. Sturdy Footwear, Gloves, Goggles, Ear Defenders to be worn for appropriate equipment. All Tools must be maintained and in safe working order before use. |
| Weather Conditions | Low | Assess weather conditions prior to commencement of working party. If conditions deemed unsuitable, posing a high level of risk, cancel working party. |
| Manual Handling | Low | Plan all lifting and handling. Demonstration of safe lifting procedures. |
| Biohazards, Chemicals and Plant Dangers | Low | Gloves to be worn when handling poisonous plants. Site Safety Talk on handling Broken Glass and Hyperdermic Needles. Follow guidelines when using plant and weed treatments. |
